
Lydda



- 31 Then the church throughout Judea, Galilee and Samaria enjoyed a time of peace. It was strengthened; and encouraged by the Holy Spirit, it grew in numbers, living in the fear of the Lord.
- 32 <u>As Peter travelled</u> about the country, he went to <u>visit the saints</u> <u>in Lydda</u>.
- 33 There he found a man named Aeneas, a paralytic who had been bedridden for eight years.
- 34 "Aeneas," Peter said to him, "<u>Jesus Christ</u> heals you. Get up and tidy up your mat." Immediately Aeneas got up.
- 35 All those who lived in Lydda and Sharon saw him and turned to the Lord.

Aeneas enabled to walk

- · Hellenistic Jew by his name
- · Likely a saint by context
- · Paralytic for eight years, bedridden
- · Jesus Christ heals you
- · Results are astounding
 - All in Lydda and Sharon
 - · Jews and Gentiles
 - All found the Lord!



Joppa

- 36 In Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (which, when translated, is Dorcas), who was always doing good and helping the poor.
- 37 About that time she became sick and died, and her body was washed and placed in an upstairs room.
- 38 Lydda was near Joppa; so when the disciples heard that Peter was in Lydda, they sent two men to him and urged him, "Please come at once!"
- 39 Peter went with them, and when he arrived he was taken upstairs to the room.
- All the widows stood around him, crying and showing him the robes and other clothing that Dorcas had made while she was still with them.
- 40 Peter sent them all out of the room; then he got down on his knees and prayed. Turning towards the dead woman, he said, "Tabitha, get up." She opened her eyes, and seeing Peter she sat up.
- 41 He took her by the hand and helped her to her feet. Then he called the believers and the widows and presented her to them alive.
- 42 This became known all over Joppa, and many people believed in the Lord.
- 43 Peter stayed in Joppa for some time with a tanner named Simon.

Tabitha resurrected from death

- · Disciple of Jesus
- · Cherished for her good works
 - Among the poor, widows
- · Disciples sent two men to Peter
- · Peter's prayer
- Presented to the believers and widows
- Astounding results
 - All over the town
 - Many believed in Jesus



Peter stays with Simon the Tanner
