

Trust: the foundation of promises



- 10 Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.
- 11 Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves.

Trust: the foundation of promises



- You have seen the Father because you have seen me.
- It is the Father in me whose words I am saying
- It is the Father in me whose work I am doing
- It is the Father in me who empowers the signs
- From this point on, you do know Him and have seen Him
- Trust in God, trust also in me

1. Promise of Ongoing Works



- 12 ¶ αμην αμην
- ESV v12 ¶ "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do;
- Words of the Father
- Work of the Father
- Authentication as from God, signs and miracles

2. Promise of Greater Works

- V 12 and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.
- GREATER?
 - Greater than you have been doing to now
 - I am leaving, now up to you
 - Greater in Quality
 - · Spirit has been with you, will be in you
 - · Authenticated by message and signs
 - Empowered by the finished work of the Cross
 - Greater in Quantity (Acts 1:7)
 - duration of your work
 - geographic reach of the gospel



3. Promise of Answered Prayer

- 13 And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.
- Aligned asks
 - In the Name of Jesus
 - To the glory of the Father
- Answer promised
- Action of the Lord
- · Always remember it is my Work
 - you will be doing when I leave



- 15 ¶ "If you love me, you will obey what I command.
- 16 And <u>I will ask the Father</u>, and he will give you another <u>Counsellor to be with you for ever</u>
- 17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.
- 18 ¶ I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.
- 19 Before long, the world will not see me any more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.
- 20 On that day you will realise that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you.
- 21 Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. <u>He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I</u> too will love him and show myself to him."

- 22 Then Judas (not Judas Iscariot) said, "But, Lord, why do you intend to show yourself to us and not to the world?"
- 23 Jesus replied, "If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.
- 24 He who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me.
- 25 ¶ "All this I have spoken while still with you.
- 26 But the <u>Counsellor</u>, the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, whom the Father will send in my name, <u>will teach</u> you all things and <u>will remind you of everything</u> I have said to you.
- 27 <u>Peace I leave with you;</u> my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
- 28 ¶ "You heard me say, 'I am going away and I am coming back to you.' If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.
- 29 I have told you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe.
- 30 I will not speak with you much longer, for the prince of this world is coming. He has
 no hold on me,
- 31 but the world must learn that I love the Father and that I do exactly what my Father has commanded me. "Come now; let us leave.
