
Salvation- R. Frazee found this chapter the most difficult....several differing views about salvation.




Salvation- R. Frazee found this chapter the most difficult....lots of confusion in those surveyed.




Salvation- R. Frazee found this chapter the most difficult....Note how varied the views are!



Salvation-



Salvation-This gate of the LORD, into which the righteous shall enter. I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation. The stone *which* the builders refused is become the head *stone* of the corner. This is the LORD'S doing; it *is* marvelous in our eyes. How did we get separated?

Gen. 3:1 “Has God said? v.4 You shall not die...You shall be as Gods



How did we get separated?

Gen. 3:21 **Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.**



Blood Sacrifice- The remedy for sin...and separation...

How did we get separated?

Gen. 3:23 “Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken.

24 So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden, Cherubim, and a flaming sword, which turned every way to keep the way of the tree of life.”

Blood Sacrifice at Exodus-

Ex. 12:13 “And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye *are*: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy *you*, when I smite the land of Egypt.”



Isaiah 53:3-6

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. ⁴ Surely he has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. ⁵ But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. ⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Isaiah 53:7-9

7. He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he opens not his mouth. 8. He was taken from prison and from judgement: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. 9. And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither *was any* deceit in his mouth.

Isaiah 53:10,11

10. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he has put *him* to grief: when You shall make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see *his* seed, he shall prolong *his* days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. ¹¹. He shall see of the travail of his soul, *and* shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

Acts 4:10-12

Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him does this man stand here before you whole. ¹¹. This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. ¹². Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.



Ep. 2: 8-10

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9. Not of works, lest any man should boast. 10. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God has before ordained that we should walk in them.



How did Jesus Speak of starting a Relationship with the Him?

a. He called of Disciples to join his team. “Be a disciple!...Come follow me”....example of F. Chan and what we do....the captain of football called the QB...calls the players to the field, has a huddle, gives the play...calls hike and we turn and go back to the bench...to wait another week to get into a huddle and feel good again..Come Follow me!.



How did Jesus Speak of starting a Relationship with the Him?

a. Be His Disciple

He called Peter, James, John, Nathanel, and all the disciples with the words “Come, follow me!”

Mt. 9:9 'And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.’”



How did Jesus speak of starting a relationship with the Him?

a. Be His Disciple

He specifically instructed those who didn't want to follow to forget all others and follow...there were those who had weddings, funerals and even family and he said...

Luke 9:62 “Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.”



How did Jesus Speak of starting a Relationship with the Him?

a. Be His Disciple

Disciples first called Christians at Antioch....Acts 11:26

A disciple lived with, followed, learned and imitated his teacher...thus we are disciples if we are in relationship with Jesus....



How did Jesus Speak of starting a Relationship with the Him?

B. Jesus Spoke of relationship as a new member of his family-

“become a His child....a child of God”

Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.

Luke 20:36 Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the children of the resurrection.



How did Jesus Speak of starting a Relationship with the Him?

B. Jesus Spoke of relationship as a new member of his family-

“become a His child....a child of God”

Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:16 The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God.



How did Jesus Speak of starting a Relationship with the Him?

C . Jesus Spoke of relationship as a new birth...to be born again.

“John 3:7 “Do not be surprised when I say to you that you need to be born again.”

1 Peter 1:23 “Being born again not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which lives and abides forever.”



C . Jesus Spoke of relationship as a new birth...to be born again. This birth has a conception date...and a delivery date....eg: Paul on road to Damascus.

Acts 9:4-6 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? ⁵ And he said, Who are you, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom you persecute: it is hard for you to kick against the pricks. ⁶ And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what will you have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told what you must do.



C . Jesus Spoke of relationship as a new birth...to be born again.. This birth is so powerful, it is described as a total new creation...

2 Cor. 5:17:

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.



D. This relationship is described as a fruitful tree-

Mt. 7:16-19 “You shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?”



D. This relationship is described as a fruitful tree-

Mt. 7:17-19 Even so every good tree brings forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree brings forth evil fruit. ¹⁸. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.



D. This relationship is described as a fruitful tree-

Mt. 7:19-20

Every tree that brings not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire 20 Wherefore by their fruits you shall know them.



E. This relationship is described as a new house (temple)

Mt. 12:43-44 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walks through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. 44. Then he said, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he finds it empty, swept, and garnished.



E. This relationship is described as a new house (temple)

Mt. 12:45

45. Then he goes and takes with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.



E. This relationship is described as a new house (temple)

1 Cor 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

1 Cor. 6:19 “What? Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which you have of God.



F. What Must I do to have relationship with God?

John 6:29 “Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.”



F. What Must I do to have relationship with God?

Rom. 10:9,10

That if thou shalt confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you shalt be saved.



F. What Must I do to have relationship with God?

Rom. 10:9,10

10 For with the heart man believes into righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

11 For the scripture says, Whosoever believes on him is not ashamed.



F. What Must I do to have relationship with God?

“Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.”
