




David persuadeth to patience and confidence in God, by the different states of the godly and the wicked.

¶ *A psalm of David.*

FRET^a not thyself because of evil-doers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity: Prov. 28. 17. & 24. 1, 19.

2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.

3 Trust in the LORD, and do good: so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

† Heb. in truth, or, stability.

present reading in the original be the true one, the meaning must be this—The transgressions of a bad man shew plainly, in the apprehension of a good one, that the former is destitute of a true fear of God. Bishop Lowth, by a slight alteration or two in the text, renders it to this effect—“The wicked man according to
God before mine eyes.”

Psalm 37.

- 1 Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity.
- 2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.
- 3 Trust in the LORD, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.
- 4 Delight yourself also in the LORD, and He shall give you the desires of your heart.
- 5 Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, and He shall bring *it* to pass.

Psalm 37.

- 6 He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.
- 7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.
- 8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; Do not fret --- *it only causes harm.*
- 9 For evildoers shall be cut off; but those who wait on the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.

¹⁰ For yet a little while and the wicked *shall be no more*; indeed, you will look carefully for his place, but it *shall be no more*.

¹¹ But the meek shall inherit the earth and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.


Psalm 37...David urges Solomon to believe God's promises and wait-

"Also I say to you, whoever confesses Me before men, him the Son of Man also will confess before the angels of God. But he who denies Me before men will be denied before the angels of God. (Lk 12:8,9)





Part #3. The Way of the Righteous

Delight yourself in the Lord-

Ex 23:30 “Little by little I will drive them out from before you until you have increased and you inherit the land”

Josh 1: 8 “This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, then you have good success.

Deuteronomy 33:25 Your sandals shall be iron and bronze; as your days, so shall your strength be.

Part #3. The Way of the Righteous

#3 Delight yourself in the Lord

Mark 9:23, "Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, **all things** are possible to him who believes."

Matthew 21:22 And all things, **whatsoever** ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

John 11:22 But I know, that even now, **whatsoever** thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee.

John 14:13 And **whatsoever** ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Part #3. Delight Yourself in the LORD

Example of Mary- "Lk 10:39 ...sitting at Jesus feet'

Example of John- the disciple whom Jesus loved

a. Jn. 13:33 leaning on Jesus bosom...whom Jesus loved (intimacy)

b. Jn. 20:2 'she ran and came to Simon and the disciple whom Jesus loved...immediacy...

c. Jn. 21:7 "the disciple whom Jesus loved said 'it is the Lord'....discernment

d. Jn. 21:20 "Peter saw the one whom Jesus loved following,,,constancy

#4. v.5 Commit yourself to the Lord

“The problem that we are facing in the church today is that we have so many Christians who have made a decision to believe in Jesus but not a commitment to follow Him. We have people who are planning to, meaning to, trying to, wanting to, going to, we just don't have people who are doing it.” (Tyler Edwards)

#5. v. 7 Rest in the Lord

“Come apart and rest a while” (Mark 6:31)

“Unless we learn to wait silently before God, we will never experience His peace!” Weirsbe.



Part #4. The Way of the Wicked

#1- v9,10 cut off, shall be nothing
v. 13 “last day coming”. v.20
“disappear” ...like burned sacrifice
turned to smoke...v.32 wicked
destroyed, v. do not slip with God

Ps. 8:5 “made Him a little lower”

man....”

v.18 “his estate shall not disappear”

v.19 “in famine filled to satisfaction”

him, but he could not
be found.” v.36



The Tree of Blameless Man

“Mark the blameless *man*, and observe the upright; For the future of *that man is* peace. But the transgressors shall be destroyed together; The future of the wicked shall be cut off. But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is their strength in the time of trouble. And the Lord shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked; and save them because they trust in Him.” (v.37-40)
